**By-law 05-2021**

**SPEED LIMIT: BROOKE, PRINCIPAL, FARM, PAUGAN, MARTINDALE AND  
FIELDVILLE ROADS - REGULATION 05-2021 - REPEAL AND REPLACE 03-2021 -  
4**

**WHEREAS** paragraph 4 of the first paragraph of section 626 of the Highway Safety Code (R.S.Q., c. C-24.2) allows a municipality to set by by-law the minimum or maximum speed of road vehicles in its territory;

**WHEREAS** the municipal council deems it appropriate to regulate the speed limits on the road network of the territory of the Municipality of the Township of Low;

**WHEREAS** the request of several residents on Brooke, Principal, Farm, Paugan, Martindale and Fieldville roads;

**WHEREAS** the presence of a secondary school on Chemin Principal;

**WHEREAS** the urbanization perimeter includes part of Martindale and Fieldville roads;

**WHEREAS** the safety of schoolchildren and residents within the urbanization perimeter;

**WHEREAS** Fieldville Road is non-linear and several residential entrances / exits are found before or after curves;

**WHEREAS** the notice of motion and filing of the project given by councilor Ghyslain Robert during a council meeting on June 7, 2021 to repeal and replace by-law 03-2021 concerning the proposal for a by-law on speeds on Brooke, Principal, Farm, Paugan, Martindale and Fieldville roads;

**WHEREAS** the Municipality of Canton de Low undertakes to communicate the speed changes by posting the changes on our website, our bulletin boards and by e-mail for those who are registered with for those registered on the electronic mailing list of the municipality .;

**WHEREAS** traffic signs will be posted at the start of each speed reduction section;

**CONSEQUENTLY**, it is

**PROPOSED** by councilor Luc Thivierge  
**SECONDED** by Councilor Maureen Rice

**AND RESOLVED** by the members of council present, that this by-law # 05-2021 concerning speed limits in the municipality of Low, be adopted and that council therefore decrees:

**ARTICLE 1**

The present by-law bears the title of By-law concerning speed limits in the municipality of Low.

**ARTICLE 2**

No one may drive a road vehicle at a speed:

- a) Exceeding 40 km / h on Brooke Road;
- b) Exceeding 40 km / h on Chemin Principal except for the school zone in front of St-Michael's school which remains at 30 km / h;
- c) Exceeding 40 km / h on Farm Road;
- d) Exceeding 40 km / h on Paugan Road;
- e) Exceeding 40 km / h on Martindale Road from Brooks Road to 152 Martindale Road; as well as
- f) Exceeding 40 km / h on Chemin Fieldville from Route 105 to Chemin du Ruisseau (within the urbanization perimeter);

**ARTICLE 3**

Appropriate signage will be installed by the Municipality of Low.

**ARTICLE 4**

Anyone who contravenes section 2 of this by-law commits an offense and is liable to a fine provided for in section 516 or 516.1 of the Highway Safety Code.

ARTICLE 5

These regulations will come into force on the day of their publication.
