### Checklist for open fires

Fire Permit	Permit required	Regulation
Outdoor Fires	No	<p>For 3x3 fires no permit is required</p> <p>The area should be safe and preferably in an outdoor fireplace with an amber screen</p> <p>Always respect your neighbors and burn only natural wood</p>

**With the use of an outdoor fireplace and a handmade or prefabricated amber screen,  
 Use may be made at any time, unless otherwise advised by SOPFEU.

Camping	Non	Must be in a safe location, at least 3 meters from any building or trailer and be at least in a tub or pit surrounded by stone
Cleaning fire/Deforestation	Yes	<p>Possible year-round, depending on the weather conditions, a burning permit must be issued by fire services management.</p> <p>The permit holder is responsible for containing his fire</p>

<b>Bonfire</b>	<b>Yes</b>	<p>Possible year-round, depending on the weather conditions, a burning permit must be issued by fire services management</p> <p>The permit holder is responsible for containing his fire</p>
<b>Fireworks</b>	<b>No</b>	Possible year-round
<b>SOPFEU Flammability Index</b>	<p><b>Allow: Low, Moderate</b>  <b>Forbidden: High, very high extreme</b></p>	

Any burning is prohibited if the winds are greater than 30 km/hour

Fire services management reserves the right to revoke any burning permit due to weather conditions

Fire services reserves the right to carry out a site visit at any time

The holder will be held responsible for an intervention of the fire services in the event that negligence is observed
