Important: On Friday, October 3rd, 2025, the station will be open continuously from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

If more than one person wishes to be a candidate for the same seat, you may exercise your voting right by going to your assigned polling station on the following dates, hours and location:

Polling day: Sunday, November 2, 2025, from 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Advance polling day: Sunday, October 26, 2025, from noon to 8 p.m. Location: 4C, d'Amour road, Low, Québec, JOX 2C0

If you are unable to travel for health reasons and are registered on the electoral roll as a resident, you can ask your election president until October 17, 2025, to vote in your room at a recognized health care facility or at your home. The same applies to your caregiver.

You can vote by mail if your domicile is not located in the territory of the municipality.

To vote by mail, you must make a written application sent to the returning officer no later than October 21, 2025. The ballot papers for voting by mail will be sent as of October 23, 2025

If you are registered to vote by mail and you have not received your ballot papers on October 27, 2025, you can contact the returning officer to obtain new ones. Ballot papers must be received at the office of the returning officer no later than Friday, October 31, 2025 at 4:30 p.m.
