Route 105 Action Plan

Road Repair Work Begins in Low

Gatineau, May 21st, 2026. - The Ministry of Transport and Sustainable Mobility is informing the public that one lane of Route 105 will be closed to traffic on weekdays in Low from May 25 to July 15. This closure is necessary to carry out road repair work.

Roadblocks and Traffic Management

- Traffic will alternate between Principal Road and Lacharity Road from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., with traffic controllers on site.

It should be noted that this project is part of the work outlined in the specific action plan for Route 105, which aims to improve the condition of this key transportation corridor in the region. This is a five-year plan, reviewed annually, that identifies priority projects for various sections of the road.

Work may be postponed, extended, or canceled due to adverse weather conditions or operational constraints. Therefore, before heading out, we recommend checking Québec 511—a handy tool for planning your trips—and downloading the Québec 511 mobile app to enable notifications.

The Ministry thanks road users for their cooperation.
